



## Point Church Temporary Relocation to Wynnum

### **Temporary Venue:**

Wynnum church building: Corner of Chestnut Street and Tingal Road, Wynnum

### **Affected Dates:**

June 10, 17, 24; July 1, 8 and 15

(six consecutive Sundays in total. No congregational lunches involved during this period – just the one Scripture, Song & Prayer/KidzTime on July 1)
